## General information

Every treatment is specific to each patient so these prices are only a guide. We will provide every patient with a plan detailing the treatment they require and the costs. You may wonder why we produce a price list if it doesn't show exact prices? We do so because our patients have asked us to help them understand what different treatments cost.

## Other treatments

Dental treatments are bespoke, so a list of every treatment available would run to a list of thousands and would be confusing. Only the most common treatments have been listed. Any additional options can be quoted for once you have had your dental consultation.

## Specialist treatments

A Specialist is a dentist who has undertaken years of post-graduate training to develop a level of expertise in a particular field of dentistry. He/she will then gain extra qualifications to enable entry onto a select Specialist Register. The use of Specialists enables us to provide our patients with a very high level of dental care.

## Examples of specialist treatment include:

### Implants

The replacement of a lost tooth or teeth with a titanium 'tooth root' that is implanted in the jaw bone. This 'tooth root' is then used to support a crown, bridge or denture.

### Endodontics

Root canal therapy to repair damage to the pulp (nerve) of a tooth or teeth. It is a complex procedure to save a tooth that is dead or dying, cure infection, remove pain and prevent further infection.

### Periodontology

The treatment of gum disease - a chronic bacterial infection that affects the gums and the bones supporting the teeth.
